



MIRTHE Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Industry program

The MIRTHE Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Industry program is a one-year appointment (may be renewed for a second year if additional NSF funds become available) of a post-doctoral fellow at Princeton University who will be **working full-time at the industry member site**.

Who can apply?

MIRTHE Industry Members interested in close collaborations in MIRTHE-related research areas

Program description

- Position should be closely related to MIRTHE research areas and match host company goals.
- Research projects should strengthen industry–university partnership through joint work and collaboration of industrial and academic mentors assigned to the fellow (industry mentor will be assigned by the company; academic mentors will be assigned through Princeton University).

Cost-sharing by the industry member (cash and/or in-kind):

- Company shall augment the annual salary (\$42,000) provided by MIRTHE based on candidate qualifications and in line with conventional company post-doctoral fellows salary.
- Company will assume responsibility to fund the research performed by the post-doctoral fellow, including materials and supplies, use of equipment and shared facilities, travel and publication costs.

How to apply:

- Company should send job description to Ms. Bernadeta Wysocka: bwysocka@princeton.edu.
- Company selects or proposes a candidate (the candidate must be eligible) - CVs received from interested applicants will be provided to the company.
- Once matched, the post-doctoral candidate, together with the company, will provide a short proposal to MIRTHE leadership consisting of job description, candidate CV, and proposed research project.
- MIRTHE leadership in consultation with industry members will decide on awarding the post-doctoral fellowship.

Applications are considered on a rolling basis; 5 appointments are expected for the 2009/2010 MIRTHE award year.
